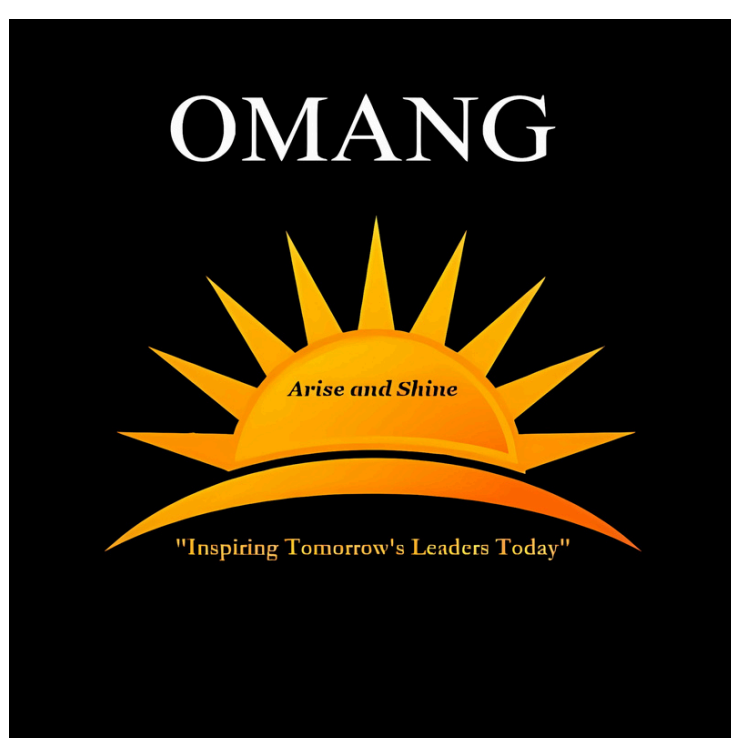


## Omang-Who Are You Youth Development Initiative
